Recipients

1. Top APR large herd : Jan Raleigh, Victoria, APR 85
Over 100 current cows.
Based on APR Herd average calculated by ADHIS in August of the previous year.
2. Top APR small herd Tim Taylor, Victoria, APR 67
Between 30 - 100 current cows.
Based on APR Herd average calculated by ADHIS in August of the previous year.
3. Most Improved APR large herd Greg and Kris Goulding, Victoria
Over 100 current cows.
Based on the difference between the APR Herd Average calculated by ADHIS in August of the previous year compared to APR Herd Average in August of the preceding year.
4. Most Improved APR small herd Doug Lindberg, Western Australia
Between 30 - 100 current cows.
Based on the difference between the APR Herd Average calculated by ADHIS in August of the previous year compared to APR Herd Average in August of the preceding year.
5. Top APR new herd Paul Cocksedge, Victoria
Over 30 current cows.
Given to the highest new entry APR herd calculated by ADHIS in August of the previous year.
APR Herd Average must be positive for this award to be granted.

Conditions

Information provided by ADHIS will be solely responsible for the calculation of the award, even if farmer records differ with the final ranking.

Includes registered and non registered cows containing UUUU or UUxU or UUx codes on herd recording data ("x" is any other variation).

The winner of Awards 1 & 2 will be ineligible to receive awards 3, 4 or 5.
